

ASHRM Annual Business Meeting

October 15, 2017, Seattle, WA

The Annual Business Meeting of the American Society for Healthcare Risk Management was held October 15, 2017, at the Washington State Convention Center in Seattle, WA.

President Midgley reviewed minutes from the September 25, 2016, Annual Business Meeting and requested a motion for approval. The motion was seconded. There was no discussion. The minutes were approved as written.

President Midgley recognized ASHRM volunteers including the Board, Past Presidents, Committee and Task Force volunteers, Faculty members, and Chapter leaders.

Geri Amori, PhD, ARM, DFASHRM, CPHRM and Fay Rozovsky, JD, MPH, DFASHRM were both awarded the Presidential Citation.
