

ASHRM ACADEMY 2022 TERMS & CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions (these "Terms") govern your registration for and participation in ASHRM Academy 2022 (the "Event") and are an agreement between American Society for Health Care Risk Management ("ASHRM," "we," "us" or "our") and you. You, the registrant, represent to us that you are authorized to enter into these Terms.

EVENT

You may only register for and attend the Event in accordance with these Terms. To register for the Event, you must complete the Event registration process. Sharing your registration with another person(s) is a violation of the Code of Conduct and may result in termination of your access to the Event.

AGE LIMITATION

Attendees must be 18 years of age on the first day of the Event to attend this event and all related events.

CANCELLATION

In-Person Programs

All cancellation and refund requests for the HRM Certificate Programs (Modules 1-3) and the ERM Certificate Program must be made in writing to ASHRM@aha.org. All refunds will be provided in the original form of payment after the ASHRM Academy concludes. Registration fees, less a \$100 cancellation fee, are refundable if written notice is received by email prior to March 18, 2022, at 4 p.m. CT. Payment to join or renew ASHRM membership is nonrefundable and nontransferable.

Blended Learning Programs

Registration fees for the Patient Safety Certificate Program, less a \$100 cancellation fee, are refundable if written notice is received no later than March 18, 2022 at 4 p.m. CT – this date is prior to the start of the self-study portion of the program.

Virtual Programs

Registration fees for the CPHRM Exam Prep Course and Risk Financing Certificate Program, less a \$100 cancellation fee, are refundable if written notice is received no later than March 18, 2022 at 4 p.m. CT – this date is prior to the start of the self-study portion of the program.

Payment to join or renew ASHRM membership is nonrefundable and nontransferable.

Substitutions

Registrants unable to attend may send an alternate. If the alternate is not a member of ASHRM and the original registrant is a member, the nonmember differential must be paid. The deadline for substitutions is March 18, 2022.
